1. About this document

1.1 Introduction

This document provides National Grid Electricity Transmission plc's (National Grid) (the Applicant) list of all objections to the grant of Compulsory Acquisition or Temporary Possession made on the Yorkshire Green Energy Enablement Project (Yorkshire GREEN or the Project). This was requested by the Examining Authority's first written questions and requests for information (ExQ1), Q4.0.1 and submitted as a standalone document at Deadline 2 'Compulsory Acquisition and Temporary Possession Objections Schedule' (Document 8.14) [REP2-044]. An updated version of this document (Document 8.14(C)) has been provided at Deadline 5 as requested by the Examination Timetable.
