We are writing under Rule 17 of the Infrastructure Planning (Examination Procedure) Rules 2010 (as amended).

1. Technical Specification for Overhead Line Clearances

The Examining Authority (ExA) requests that the Applicant submits a complete copy of the following document into the Examination:

- Energy Networks Association's Technical Specification 43-8 - Overhead Line Clearances (Issue 5, published 2019).

2. Access off A659 at Tadcaster

Further to submissions received at Deadline 7, the Examining Authority (ExA) requests that the Applicant responds to the following point of clarification:

- Following discussion at Compulsory Acquisition Hearing (CAH) 2 [EV-008b] and [REP6-059], it is the ExA's understanding that the Applicant had agreed that the access track to the proposed West Cable Sealing End Compound along the north eastern boundary of Mr Watson's land (with that in the ownership of Samuel Smith Old Brewery) could be accommodated at a width of 4 metres. The illustrative plan set out in Appendix A of the Applicant's Deadline 7 submission '[Document 8.29.5](#):

Applicant's Deadline 7 Response to Compulsory Acquisition Hearing 2 (CAH2)
Action Points' shows this with a width of 7 metres.

- Explain why a track of 7 metres width is shown on the illustrative plan;
- If it remains the Applicant's position that a track with a width of 4 metres could be accommodated, submit a version of the illustrative plan that shows this; and
- For the avoidance of doubt, confirm whether the reference to the A361 in the title of Appendix A should instead be to the A659.

All of the above material should be submitted by Deadline 8 (Wednesday 13 September 2023).
