- The Programme Document has not been published on the Applicant's website; please can you confirm when this will be published?
- No reference in Programme Document to this document being shared with local authorities/statutory consultees/others. Which stakeholders will the Applicant share the Programme Document with and when? What are the points of contention with the relevant stakeholder/s? How does the Applicant propose to mitigate/ resolve?
- The Issues Tracker has not been included in the Programme Document (although there is reference to it being reviewed by the Planning Inspectorate) - please confirm why this has not been included. Which stakeholders will this be shared with and when? How and when will the Applicant agree the Potential Main Issues for Examination (PMIE) with statutory consultees and local authorities?
- Please confirm why dates for the following have not been included in the Programme Document, and when will these be included in the Programme Document?
