Further to the invitation below to make representations/respond to an application for a Preesall Gas Storage Facility, I write to state that the proposed project once again presents fear, stress and uncertainty for ourselves as local residents. This includes:

- (i) The fear of increased household insurance costs. I raised this matter several years ago in person to the applicant (then known as Canatxx) and received nil response.
- (ii) Devaluation of our property
- (iii) Danger on deteriorating roads caused by the increased traffic. Note that local roads are already seriously affected by congestion, weather damage and Council repair cuts

We should be protected from the fear, stress and uncertainty that such applications cause and I trust that this will be the final (unsuccessful) application in order that we can live peacefully in the knowledge that the taxes that we pay are not being wasted in dealing with such matters.
