Representations on Senergy report

Dear Mr Scott

The Senergy report states that in their opinion there is less than a 2% probability that the volume of gas would to be stored would reach 300mcm.

It is therefore clear that the volume of 300mcm which was set by the IPC as a condition for the application to proceed, will not be met.

The estimated volume which Senergy believe can be safely stored is 124mcm with a 90% probability. This volume is less than 50% of the required 300mcm.

The expert report which you have received with the Protect Wyre Group representation casts doubt on the Senergy estimate and suggests that the predicted volume may be as low as 87mcm.

Therefore, for the reason that the storage volumes predicted by Senergy, and by Protect Wyre Group are less than 50% of the minimum volume set by the IPC, the application should again be rejected.
