On behalf of Lach Dennis Parish Council, we wish to submit the following objections outlined below:-

The A530 King Street is already at full capacity. Further development of this nature will only exacerbate the problem especially at the construction phase. Worthy of note was a recent fatality at the Whatcroft/Davenham Road junction.

Concerns were raised regarding the close proximity of the proposed route of the HS2, geology, vibrations etc. Also of the Warmingham to Lostock pipelines, permission granted but as yet not constructed adjacent to the A530. We are also concerned regarding environmental issues, the loss of wildlife habitat, loss of agricultural land and the possible dumping of brine from the cavity construction into the Mersey estuary at Runcorn via the Whitley Pumping station. Therefore Lach Dennis Parish Council strongly object and cannot support this application.

We would appreciate confirmation from you that these comments will be given due consideration.
