I have considered the material submitted by the applicant. I note that the changes are within the order limits and are made at the request of one of the landowners affected by the proposed development. I have concluded that the proposed changes to the scheme are not 'material' in the sense that accepting them would be likely to result in prejudice to any party. Given this, and having regard to the fact that information on the changes has been made available to interested parties, I have concluded that the changes should be accepted for consideration in the examination as part of the proposed development.
