Thank you for being able to provide comments on the development, Pre Planning Enquiry EN040001 - Teesside Flexible Regas Port Limited.

The proposed facility is close to the Hartlepool nuclear power station licensed site and to the National Policy Statement for Nuclear Power Generation (EN6) potential development site neighbouring Hartlepool Power Station.

I have engaged with external hazards who have advised there are areas of concern, the high pressure pipeline, risk of coastal flooding and the distance the proposed site is to Hartlepool nuclear power station. Whilst ONR does not advise against this development, if planning permission is granted, ONR advises that the developer should consult with both ONR and Hartlepool Power Station in the planning process to address the implications of the proposed facility.
