




Centrica Storage Limited	Venture House 42-54 London Road Staines Middlesex TW18 4HF	Category 1	Consultation material was sent to Centrica Storage Limited's parent company, Centrica Plc. Through diligent inquiry and discussions with Centrica it was understood that Millstream, Maidenhead Road, Windsor was the most appropriate address (see list of Section 44 Consultees in Appendix 9 Consultation Report Appendices Part 1 (Doc Ref 5.1.1)). Since that time discussions with Paul Hardy and Adam Posner of Centrica Storage Limited have been ongoing – see attached minutes dated 20 October 2014.
Ralph Edward Ward		Category 1	After diligent inquiry and discussions with Mr Ward he requested that National Grid contact him at his business address, Frank Hill & Sons, 18 Market Place, Patrington (See list of Section 44 Consultees in Appendix 9 Consultation Report Appendices Part 1 (Doc Ref 5.1.1)). Mr Ward also attended the consultation event at Paull on 25 September 2014 with Mr Charles Frances Hill, joint owner of plots 47, 48, 49, 50, 51, 52, 53 – see Feedback Form completed by Mr Hill on behalf of "Ward & Hill (Trustees)" (attached) contained in the S47 Statutory Consultation folder of the Reg 5(5) information provided. Mr Ward is also the Clerk of the South Holderness Internal Drainage Board and has signed the attached Statement of Common Ground.
Pamela Black		Category 1	This land was included within the consultation zone for the section 47 consultation. Following the Supplementary Consultation, a traffic engineering audit identified the need for minor alterations to the construction access route. This introduced the need for temporary use of the subsoil, entirely within the highway boundary of plot 122, which was a late addition to the Book of Reference. An agent for National Grid visited Mrs Black at her home address on 19 March 2015 to discuss the Application and she provided information about the land on a plan. A copy of the agent's note and marked-up plan by Mrs Black is attached. Mrs Black will also have the opportunity to comment at section 56 stage.
