**Re: River Humber Gas Replacement Pipeline (EN060004)**

Thank you for your letter of 14 September (reference EN060004)

Trinity House is the General Lighthouse Authority (GLA) for England, Wales, the Channel Islands and Gibraltar. Trinity House is a corporation established by Royal Charter, and its powers as a GLA are principally derived from the Merchant Shipping Act 1995, as amended. Our primary role is to deliver a reliable, efficient and cost-effective aids to navigation service for the benefit and safety of all mariners commensurate with the level of risk. This includes the superintendence and management of all lighthouses, buoys and beacons within our area.

Trinity House is also a landowner in the area and our Goxhill Farm property will be affected by the proposed project. This response deals only with Trinity House's interest in the project in relation to our statutory functions concerning the safety of navigation in tidal waters, and not as landowner in the area. Our managing agents, Savill's, will contact you in respect of our property interests at Goxhill Farm separately, if necessary.

Responses to first round of written questions.

With regard to the first round of written questions we would comment as follows:

11.1	Q	Flooding the tunnel on its completion will require the placement of pumps and pipes within the intertidal area at Goxhill for a period of approximately 2-weeks. Would there be a requirement for night-time warning lights and are there any other matters that you would draw to the attention of the ExA to consider during the examination?
	A	There may be a requirement for day and night time marking with aids to navigation. Appropriate consideration will be given by Trinity House in consultation with the Local Lighthouse Authority (ABP) and direction given as necessary.
