

Hello Nicky,

I've been through the flood response plan, and applied our "self assessment" as discussed - please see attached for your information. As we discussed on the phone, we carry out a desk top assessments of flood evacuation plans, which can't offer any guarantees that a plan will work in practise, but gives a view of whether the plan has the elements that you would expect to see in a successful plan.

The plan covers all the elements that we would expect to see in a flood plan and includes added features such a telemetry to trigger evacuations. However, as mentioned in the plan, the triggers for evacuation and the evacuation routes need to be added and this may influence whether it is necessary to have an on site refuge.

I think the plan therefore gives assurance in its current state, but it would need additional work if consent was given prior to use.
