Request for further information and notification of change of timetable

Thank you for consulting Historic England on the above, Historic England can only comment  
on whether the suggested changes alter the impact on the historic environment.

Since or during the application process an application to schedule a part of field 7, adjacent  
to field 8 (the Mitigation Land) has been considered by Historic England's Listing Team. The  
case is still under deliberation, however it should be noted that this area may be considered  
an archaeological area of national importance.

This has been raised with the archaeological consultant to the River Humber Gas Pipeline  
Replacement Project. There is no proposal to alter the area of land which contains the  
archaeological site at present. If the site is scheduled there will be the requirement to apply  
for Scheduled Monument Consent for works which impact on the site, regardless of whether  
these works require planning permission.

Historic England does not consider that this new information alters the existing application;  
the addition of the new parcel of land and additional gates does not alter our understanding  
of the historic environment in this area.
