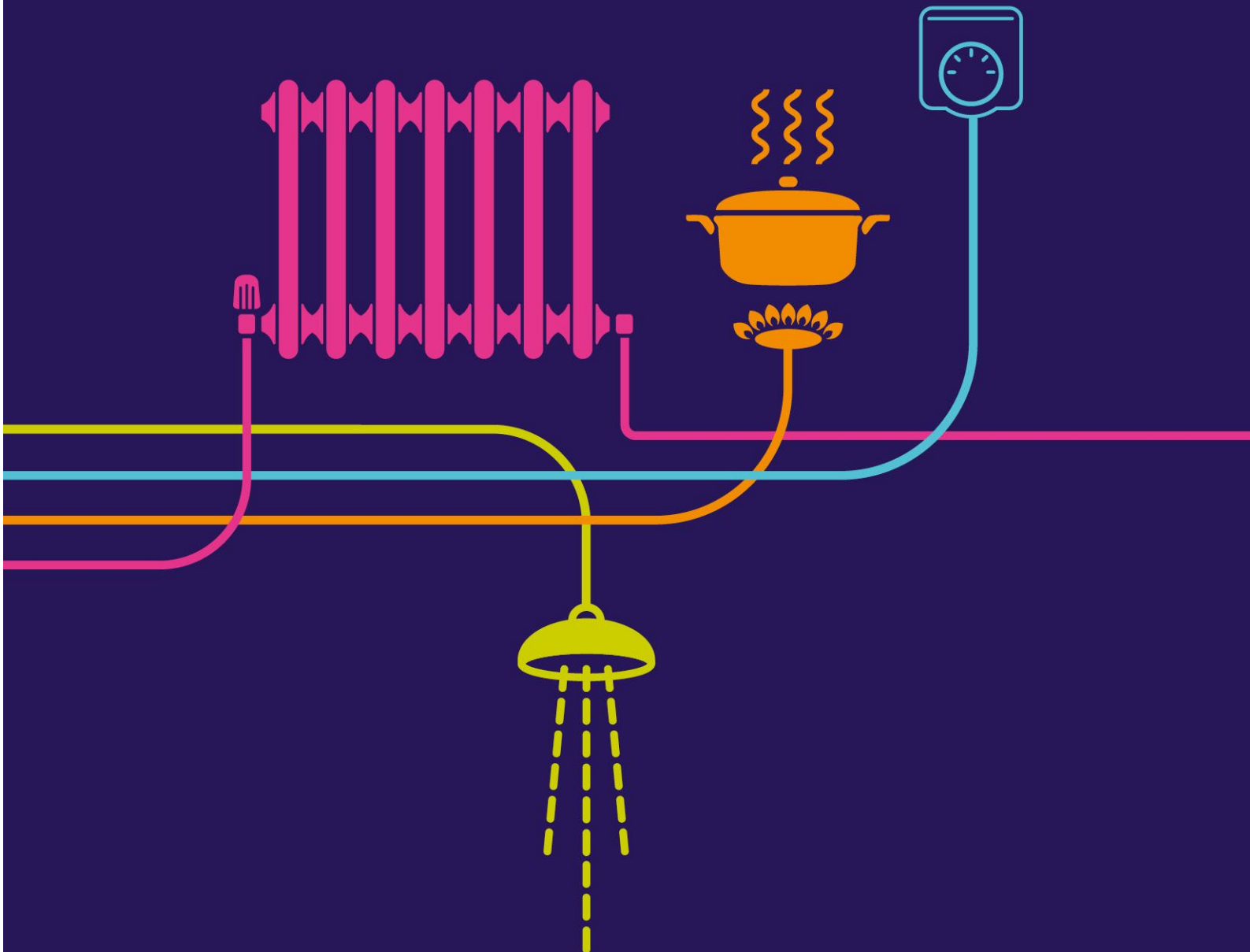


# Position Statement on Representations Received
