Notice is hereby given that the Examining Authority will be holding a compulsory acquisition hearing under section 92 of the Planning Act 2008 (the “2008 Act”) and issue specific hearings under section 91 of the 2008 Act further to the application with PINS reference EN070001 (the “Application”) made by National Grid Carbon Limited (“National Grid”) of 1-3 Strand London WC2N 5EH for a DCO under sections 14(1)(g) and 37 of the 2008 Act for the “Project” (summarised in paragraph 1 below). The Application was submitted by National Grid to the Secretary of State, c/o The Planning Inspectorate (“PINS”), on 18 June 2014 and was accepted for examination on 16 July 2014.

This day is reserved for the discussion of any residual issues from the previous hearings. These will be clearly identified by the Examining Authority if they are unable to examine the issue to their satisfaction within the allotted time period. If no issues are identified by the Examining Authority over the course of the previous fortnight as requiring further examination, then there will be no hearing on this day.

**The Application**

- The Application relates to a cross country pipeline for the transportation of captured carbon dioxide and associated development in the Yorkshire and Humber region from a point near Drax in North Yorkshire to a point near Barmston on the Holderness Coast in East Riding of Yorkshire. This comprises:
  - A 75km onshore pipeline (comprising a 67km cross country pipeline and interconnecting local pipelines) with an external diameter of up to 610 millimetres;
  - A Pipeline Internal Gauge (“PIG”) Trap approximately 1.9km north of the village of Drax grid reference 466709E 428121N;
  - Multi-junction site, approximately 1km south of the village of Drax grid reference 466953E 425420N
  - Three Block Valve sites – one located approximately 3.0km to the south of the village of Holme on Spalding Moor, grid reference 482169E 435618N, one approximately 2.4km to the south of the village of Middleton-on-the-Wolds, grid reference 495143E 447198N, and the third located approximately 1.3km to the south-east of the village of Skerne, grid reference 505669E 454650N;
  - A Pumping Station, grid reference 515958E 460955N located approximately 1.8km to the north of the village of Barmston on the Holderness Coast;
  - Interconnecting local pipelines and other associated development and associated works;
  - Ancillary works including: temporary construction compounds, permanent and temporary access roads, and service corridors.

The proposed DCO will authorise amongst other things:

- the construction, operation and maintenance of a cross country pipeline in excess of 16.093km in length to transport captured carbon dioxide, and is therefore a nationally significant infrastructure project under section 14(1)(g) of the Planning Act 2008;
- associated development under section 115(2) of the Planning Act 2008;

- The Application also seeks authorisation for the following, amongst other things, in respect of the Project:
  - the compulsory acquisition of land and/or rights as shown on the Land Plan and Book of Reference comprised within the Application documents; temporary use and possession of land for carrying out construction of the Project; interference with, suspension and extinguishment of easements and other rights over or affecting land; powers to survey and investigate land, to undertake protective works to buildings and to lop trees overhanging the proposed works;
  - permanent and/or temporary changes to the highway network; provisions relating to streets; temporary stopping up of highways; temporary interference with public rights of way;
  - the application and disapplication of legislation relevant to the Project;
  - a deemed marine licence under section 149A Planning Act 2008 for construction of the pipeline in the intertidal area between mean high and mean low water marks, and also running the pipeline beneath the River Ouse;
  - such ancillary, incidental and consequential works, permits, consents or provisions as are necessary for the Project.

**Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA)**

- The Project is an EIA development for the purposes of the Infrastructure Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations 2009. Accordingly an Environmental Statement accompanied the application.
