4. Issue specific hearing – draft Development Consent Order

This hearing will concentrate on the specific issue of the draft Development Consent Order (DCO). This is the order which the Secretary of State would make if he wished to consent the application. Discussion at this hearing is 'without prejudice'; this means that parties may make contributions to improve the quality of the draft DCO without invalidating their own positions of support or opposition to the scheme as a whole. Irrespective of its recommendation, the ExA is required to present a draft DCO to the Secretary of State. Discussion about the specifics of the draft DCO does not indicate that the ExA has made up its mind about the application. The hearing into the draft DCO is likely to be of a technical nature and will be based on the specific wording of the order.

On all days, the venue will open to the public half an hour prior to the start of the hearing. The hearings will close once business has been concluded. The ExA will allow comfort breaks and a one hour lunch break.
