Following the representation submitted by Network Rail Infrastructure Limited ("Network Rail") on 12 September 2014, Network Rail has been in discussions with the promoter for the above scheme. It is anticipated that agreement can be reached for the inclusion of Network Rail's standard protective provisions within the DCO and for other appropriate agreements regarding Network Rail's land interests.

On that basis, I can confirm that Network Rail does not intend to attend the preliminary meeting for this application on 19 November 2014. That said, it does of course reserve its position as regards the points made in its representation, should agreement with the promoter not be possible.
