This representation is made with specific regard to land referred to in the Book of Reference (Document 4.3) and the Land Plans (Document Reference 2.1) as Plot Numbers 665 to 676 in the ownership of Mr S R Craven and Mr R R Craven which is proposed to be affected by the scheme. It is requested that the Examining Authority take into consideration the following points:

- 1) The proposed eight year period from award of the DCO for compulsory rights to be exercisable is too long.
- 2) The route of the proposed pipeline should be aligned so as to cause the minimum amount of disturbance to agricultural operations.

- 3) Prior to the commencement of any work, the existence of any field underdrainage systems should be established and a scheme of underdrainage rectification/ reinstatement should be agreed to the satisfaction of the affected party.
- 4) Any works relating to the proposed scheme should only be carried out when ground conditions are suitable.
- 5) Topsoil should be stored separately at the side of the pipeline during construction and should be replaced to the satisfaction of the affected party.
