1 Accompanied Site Visit: Suggested Itinerary

1.1 BACKGROUND

- 1.1.1 At the preliminary meeting for the Yorkshire and Humber CCS Cross Country Pipeline DCO, National Grid was invited to produce a suggested itinerary for an accompanied site visit for the Examining Authority (ExA).
- 1.1.2 The timetable for the examination as set out in the Rule 8 letter (dated 25th November 2014) states that the 27th January and 28th January 2015 has been reserved for the accompanied site visit. Comments from interested parties on where the ExA should visit must be submitted by Deadline 1 (18th December 2014).

1.2 ITINERARY

- 1.2.1 The application includes a pipeline that is in total 74km long and a series of above ground installations. Given the length of the pipeline it would be impractical to walk the entire route; alternatively the suggested itinerary comprises a series of visits to particular points of interest including all sites of above ground installations.
- 1.2.2 A mini bus will be provided by the applicant but some areas are inaccessible and a small amount of walking will be inevitable. Notification of attendees is required to wscawn@camarquepr.com at least two weeks prior to the visit to ensure the availability of transport.
- 1.2.3 Given the short days at the time of year when the site visit will be completed it is suggested that the site visit is split over two days. The site visits will not take two whole days and can be completed conformably during this period with adequate time to visit each site in detail.
- 1.2.4 The suggested itinerary for the two days is below:
- Day 1: Drax - Dalton Block Valve - Drax
 - Day 2: Barmston – Skerne Block Valve - Barmston

DAY 1:

9:30 for 10:00 start: Meet at Drax Sports and Social club, Drax Sports & Social Club Main Road, Drax, Selby, North Yorkshire YO8 8PJ.

Visit Drax PIG Trap Site (*PPE to be provided as this part of a CDM site and accompanied by representative from Drax Power Limited TBC if this option is acceptable to the ExA*)

Drive through Drax Village (at main road crossings)

Church Dyke Lane Crossing

Multi-Junction (via Wade House Lane entrance)

Brind Lane rail crossing

Tollingham Block Valve and Tollingham Construction Compound (Skiff Lane)

Lunch stop Holme on Spalding Moor (*TBC but should be indoor in preparation for inclement weather*)

Kiplingcoates crossing

Hudson Way Crossing

Dalton Block Valves

A1079 crossing (layby)

Return Drax Sports and Social Club (3 – 4 pm finish)
