### **Application for the Yorkshire and Humber Carbon Capture and Storage (CCS) Cross Country Pipeline Development Consent Order (Reference: EN070001)**

In response to the Rule 8 letter from the Examining Authority (ExA) dated 25<sup>th</sup> November 2014, please find enclosed two copies of our submission documents for Deadline 2 which are guided by Annex B. A full list of the submission documents can be found in table format at document 11.7.

The following Deadline 2 submission documents listed at Annex B of the ExA's Rule 8 letter are considered relevant to National Grid (as the applicant) and are enclosed with this submission. **(vii) – (viii) Habitat Regulations Assessment**

National Grid has prepared a comprehensive offshore technical evidence report at document 11.3 (entitled: Offshore Scheme Technical Evidence Report). This report is designed to satisfy Natural England's request for offshore information. The submission of the updated screening matrices along with a copy of a Shadow Appropriate Assessment will be issued to PINS on the 26th January. This approach will enable Natural England to comment on the technical report before the Shadow AA is finalised.

**Additional Deadline 2 submission documents**

**Book of Reference (Rev B) Parts 1 and 3 (Document 4.3)**

Parts 1 and 3 of the Book of Reference have been updated to reflected changes in land ownership and tenancy since the DCO was submitted in June 2014, and are submitted at Deadline 2. This revised document includes an appended track changed copy which identifies where alterations have been made to Parts 1 and 3.

**Addendum to Planning Statement (Document 7.1.1)**

An addendum to the Planning Statement has been prepared in response to comments received from relevant Local Planning Authorities (including East Riding of Yorkshire Council, Selby District Council and North Yorkshire County Council). This document provides further clarification regarding a number of Local Plan policies in the context of the Onshore Scheme.

**Code of Construction Practice Revision B (Document 7.5)**

The Code of Construction Practice has been updated and can be found at document 7.5 (Rev B). The document has been updated to reflect discussions with stakeholders during Statement of Common Ground dialogue.

**Minerals Report (Document 11.2)**

National Grid has prepared a Minerals Report which can be found at document 11.2 in response to written questions raised by the ExA and the written representation submitted at deadline 1 by the Mineral Products Association.

**Document 2.4 Access Rights of Way and Stopping up Plans Sheet 1 (revision B)**

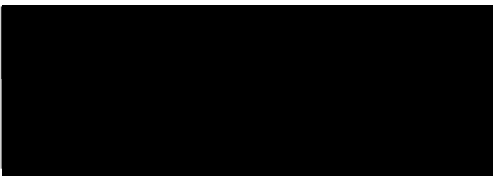
