Application for the Yorkshire and Humber Carbon Capture and Storage (CCS) Cross Country Pipeline Development Consent Order (Reference: EN070001)

In response to the Rule 8 letter from the Examining Authority (ExA) dated 25th November 2014, please find enclosed two hard copies and two CD copies of our submission documents for Deadline 3, which are guided by Annex B. A full list of the submission documents can be found in table format at document 12.9.

The following Deadline 3 submission documents listed at Annex B of the ExA's Rule 8 letter are considered relevant to National Grid (as the applicant) and are enclosed with this submission. Greater detail on each and an explanation of additional information submitted is set out below.

- (i) Applicant's revised draft DCO;
- (ii) Updated Statements of Common Ground;
- (iii) Any Information Requested by the ExA at the Hearings;
- (iv) Written Summaries of Oral Cases put at Hearings; and
- (v) Any further information requested by the ExA for this deadline.

(i) Applicant's revised draft DCO (Documents 3.1, 3.2 and 3.4)

National Grid submits the following in respect of matter (i):

- A revised draft DCO (Document 3.1, Rev C);
- A revised Explanatory Memorandum (Document 3.2, Rev C); and
- Commentary on Revision C of the Draft Development Consent Order (Document 3.4)

(ii) Statements of Common Ground

Further to the Statements of Common Ground (SoCG) submitted at Deadline 1 and the examination hearing sessions, updated SoCG have been prepared and agreed between National Grid and various stakeholders.

As before, National Grid intends to issue hard, signed copies of the SoCG to the ExA for completeness shortly after the submission of electronic copies. The SoCG submitted for Deadline 3 are detailed below:

Securing our energy supply for future generations.

- Statement of Common Ground between North Yorkshire County Council and National Grid at Deadline 3 (Document 9.1);
- Statement of Common Ground between East Riding of Yorkshire Council and National Grid at Deadline 3 (Document 9.2);
- Statement of Common Ground between Natural England and National Grid at Deadline 3 (Document 9.5);
- Statement of Common Ground between Environment Agency and National Grid at Deadline 3 (Document 9.6);
- Statement of Common Ground between Marine Management Organisation and National Grid at Deadline 3 (Document 9.7);
- Statement of Common Ground between Selby Area IDB and National Grid at Deadline 3 (Document 9.10); and
- Statement of Common Ground between Ouse and Humber Drainage Board and National Grid at Deadline 3 (Document 9.12).

The following SoCG are not submitted at Deadline 3 as all matters were resolved with the stakeholders at Deadline 1:

- Statement of Common Ground between English Heritage and National Grid at Deadline 1 (Document 9.4);
- Statement of Common Ground between Highways Agency and National Grid at Deadline 1 (Document 9.8); and
- Statement of Common Ground between Trinity House and National Grid at Deadline 1 (Document 9.9).

The following SoCG have not been updated at this deadline as they are materially no different to those submitted at Deadline 1:

- Statement of Common Ground between Selby District Council and National Grid at Deadline 1 (Document 9.3); and
- Statement of Common Ground between Beverley and North Holderness IDB and National Grid at Deadline 1 (Document 9.11).

National Grid and Selby District Council remain in discussions regarding various points raised in the Local Impact Report. Outstanding matters mainly relate to noise and it is anticipated that an updated SoCG will be submitted at Deadline 4. National Grid also remains in discussions with Beverley and North Holderness IDB and await further feedback on the SoCG.

Written Summaries of Oral Evidence and Supporting Information Report (Document 12.1)

A consolidated document (12.1), including appendices is submitted by National Grid at Deadline 3, addressing matters (iii)-(iv).

Additional Deadline 2 submission documents

Code of Construction Practice Revision C (Document 7.5)

The Code of Construction Practice has been updated and can be found at document 7.5 (Rev C). The document has been updated to reflect discussions with stakeholders during SoCG dialogue alongside oral evidence given during the Hearings.

Response to MPA Lift and Shift Provision (Document 12.2)

National Grid's response to the Mineral Products Association's proposed Lift and Shift Provision, as tabled and accepted as an examination document by the ExA at the Hearings, is included at Document 12.2.

Position in respect of statutory undertakers and others (Document 12.3)

A schedule of discussions as of the 13th February 2015 with statutory undertakers is included at Document 12.3.

Updated Schedule of Compulsory Acquisition (Document 12.4)

A schedule of Compulsory Acquisition as of the 13th February 2015 is included at Document 12.4.

Protocol for Delivering Biodiversity Enhancement (Document 12.5)

A protocol for delivering biodiversity enhancement is included at document 12.5. This protocol is included as a separate document for the purpose of Deadline 3 but will ultimately form an appendix to the Code of Construction Practice.

Tracked Changed Comparison Version of the Code of Construction Practice from Submission Version to Rev C (Document 12.6)

A tracked Changed Comparison version of the Code of Construction Practice is submitted at Deadline 3 to illustrate the changes made since the submission version, as requested by the ExA at the Hearings.

A schedule documenting where actions requested by the Planning Inspectorate’s Case Manager (as part of the summary of each hearing) have been addressed is included at Document 12.7.

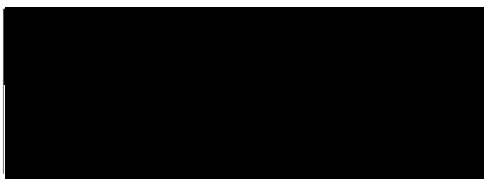
