Afternoon Sarah,

In respect of the above, I would be grateful if you could advise the ExA of the following:

As confirmed by National Grid in respect of Agenda Item 1 at the issue-specific hearing on construction on 3 February 2015, National Grid has committed to a minimum depth of cover for the pipeline beneath the River Ouse of 3.5m beneath its true clean bottom.

Work No. 5C in Schedule 1 (*authorised development*) of Rev C of the DCO was amended to reflect this by insertion of the text underlined below. However, the double underlined text was left in error.

Work No. 5C – A carbon dioxide pipeline from and beneath Church Dike Lane, approximate chainage 7458 metres, to Barmby Road (Work No. 5D), approximate chainage 11,089 metres, laid in trench, in sleeves or by trenchless methods (save beneath the true clean bottom of the River Ouse where it must be laid by trenchless methods); such pipeline to be not less than 1.2 metres below ground surface (or not less than 1.7 metres below the true clean bottom of rivers (other than beneath the River Ouse, where the pipeline is to be not less than 3.5 metres below its true clean bottom)),

streams, open drains, canals or dykes but excluding land drains, culverts or sewers and not less than 2 metres below public highways and the true clean bottom of the River Ouse where applicable).

Please note that National Grid commits to deletion of the double underlined text in the version of the DCO to be submitted at Deadline 4 on 4 March 2015.
