Further to our meeting on 25th January, please find below a series of points which I would like taken into consideration in your deliberations concerning the above application:

The Humber CSS Cross Country Pipeline crosses the land at Skiff farm for several hundred meters.

The area involved is not eligible for the Rural Payments Agency and as such will have to be taken out of the scheme temporarily. If construction is delayed, for whatever reason, and alternatively fenced, the business may have to withdraw from Rural payments for more than one year and no consideration has been given to this fact. The cut off point in any one year is the 15th May allow two

or three weeks prior to the cut off date to establish a crop then the last date would be the last week in April. Consequently, I would be severely disadvantaged if the business was not compensated for this loss. Therefore a timeline would need to be put in place with regard to construction which allowed the time needed to notify the RPA.

Work near the pipeline.

There is ongoing work near the pipe line which I have flagged up with the officials from the Yorkshire and Humber project.

I think the deepening of the proposed fishing lake may cause damage to the pipe line.
