Thank you for consulting Surrey County Council.

Surrey County Council finds the consultation on the Southampton to London Pipeline Project was adequately undertaken.

Minerals and Waste Planning Authority

Considers that Surrey County Council has been adequately consulted by ESSO.

Transport Development Planning

Considers that ESSO have been consulting us fully as expected.

Highways and Transport Service

Considers the consultation has been adequately undertaken.

Strategic Network Resilience

Are satisfied that we have been consulted on the ordinary watercourse consent proposals and that we have had a chance to feed into this process.

Heritage Conservation

Jacob's, on behalf of Esso, have undertaken initial archaeological assessment of the potential archaeological impact of the proposed Southampton- London pipeline, and undertaken early consultation and discussion with this office regarding preferred routes as well as the key archaeological concerns, and potential mitigation. Subsequent to this, a draft mitigation strategy was produced. On reviewing this proposed document in March 2019, we sent a number of comments and requested amendments to this document. As far as we are aware, the applicant is still working on these amendments, which we would expect to see addressed in any submission to the planning inspectorate.

This point notwithstanding, the Heritage Conservation Team are satisfied that the initial consultation has been satisfactorily completed.
