Dear Sir/Madam

I note that the acceptance of submissions from non-Interested Parties is at the discretion of the Examining Authority.

This email is sent on behalf of NHS Hounslow Clinical Commissioning Group which is geographically coterminous with the London Borough of Hounslow. Whilst the proposal only covers a small part of the London Borough of Hounslow and the Greater London Authority (GLA) area this location is where the proposed aviation fuel pipeline connects to the West London Terminal storage facility. We note the Planning Inspectorate's concern that GLA data has not been included in the baseline assessment for the Environmental Statement and that the approach to omit the GLA data should be justified and agreed by the relevant consultation bodies. The applicant states that GLA data would not add additional value to the assessment, as the environment of this area is consistent with the rest of the study area. Nevertheless, the CCG is concerned that the health impact of the proposal in this location, particularly arising from construction activity and from the risk of major accidents and natural disasters has not been properly assessed without the use of GLA data to assess the baseline conditions.
