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1. Accompanied Site Inspection

1.1 Introduction

- 1.1.1 The purpose of this document is to set out the Applicant's proposed draft itinerary for an Accompanied Site Inspection (ASI).
- 1.1.2 It is assumed that following the submission of suggested locations by other parties this itinerary will need to evolve. The Applicant would appreciate early information on whether it is responsible for developing the itinerary further and arranging access to private land included in the proposed itinerary.

1.2 Itinerary

- 1.2.1 The proposed itinerary for the ASI is provided in Table 1.1 below, taking place on Tuesday 26 November 2019 (and possibly Thursday 28 November if required).
- 1.2.2 The itinerary presented in Table 1.1 is supported by a plan showing the proposed route, contained in Appendix A of this document.
- 1.2.3 This is a draft itinerary for the ASI and is subject to input from the Examining Authority and other interested parties. The Applicant has communicated with landowners and received permission where necessary and will inform them of attendee numbers once confirmed. Following guidance provided from the ExA at the preliminary meeting, the itinerary only contains locations that are not publicly accessible and that were not part of the ExA's unaccompanied site inspection. For those sites we have chosen the purpose for the visit to each of the sites is outlined in the table below.
- 1.2.4 This draft itinerary is based on attendees parking at the starting location and using the minibus to transport to the sites. If further flexibility is required (for example, a wish to attend a single site), more detailed arrangements to enable this option will be incorporated into the final plan. The Applicant has requested permission for parking at St. James' School should it be required however this will be reviewed when the sites are confirmed and travel arrangements developed.
- 1.2.5 Lunch will not be provided. Attendees may bring their own and a lunch break will be scheduled into the itinerary, in a location where there will be multiple options available for people to purchase their own lunch if they wish. The Applicant has allotted one hour for a suitable lunch break.



1.2.6 At some locations visitors will be required to walk, therefore the Applicant will provide high-visibility tabards (to be worn over own coats), gloves, safety helmets and safety specs (depending on the site) and safety footwear. The Applicant will therefore require shoe sizes for all attendees, and everyone attending will be encouraged to use these. Please ensure suitable clothing to the weather conditions is worn.
