No particular items of note that we wanted to be pointed out during the inspection.

There was just one part of the route that I was going to explain and that related to the section of the Order Limits (temporary possession only) that extended diagonally into the main school playing field in front of the school. This working area is a contingency for a stringing out area if a HDD is needed underneath the railway line that bounds the southern side of St James School. We are hopeful that a HDD will not be required and that the railway crossing can be carried out with a bored or tunnelled trenchless method that would not require the stringing out area. However to confirm that we do need to carry out a borehole in the corner of the school playing field by the railway crossing to confirm the ground conditions are suitable. We are hopeful that the school can grant the project access so that the borehole can be carried out during the Easter holidays.

I'll await confirmation either way on the attendance question discussed earlier.
