Hi,

We have received a letter as a statutory undertaker and would like to register as an interested party. GTC operate multiple utility networks under various licenses, covering gas, electric, water and fibre networks. An initial review of the current proposed route indicates that there may be impact with some of our cables/ pipes in a few locations. Should diversion of our assets be required we have assumed that the constructor will apply to us in line with the New Road and Street Works Act Coe of Practice: Measures necessary where apparatus is affected by major works (diversionary works). In addition, in line with safe digging practices, our network drawings can be obtained via our plant enquiry system https://pe.gtc-uk.co.uk/plant_enquiry/
