Hampshire County Council have had the opportunity to review the Examining Authority's recommended changes to the applicant's draft Development Consent Order, and those submissions of relevance made at Deadline 6.

We can confirm that we are content with the recommended changes as tabled, including the proposed change to Schedule 2 Requirement 7 (1) which requires the detailed Construction Traffic Management Plan(s) to now be submitted to and approved by the local planning authority, following consultation with the relevant highway authority.

We also endorse the changes made by the applicant to the draft DCO at Deadline 6, including those relating to the use of the permit schemes, (Article 9) which is now considered to be much clearer, with the limitations reflecting discussions with the applicant. We note that Article 35 has been accordingly corrected following the new wording in Article 9 and reverted back to its original purpose.

Finally, we can confirm that we are aware of the applicant's proposal for protective provisions in Schedule 9, new Part 5, to disapply Section 23 of the Land Drainage Act 1991. We can confirm that we are content with the proposed wording as principally agreed between Surrey County Council and the applicant in this regard and are satisfied that they adequately fulfil the requirements that Section 23 of the Land Drainage Act 1991 would otherwise provide for.

We trust that the above is of assistance to the Examining Authority as the Examination reaches its conclusion.
