Further to your email of 05 August 2020, the response from Runnymede Borough Council to item 6) of the attached letter is as follows:

*6. The Secretary of State requests that **Runnymede Borough Council** should provide an update on whether the modifications to the wording of some elements of the Local Plan affect the Council's position as set out in the Statement of Common Ground.*

The Council can confirm its position relating to planning policy matters as set out in table 3.1 of the Statement of Common Ground signed 2<sup>nd</sup> April 2020 remains unchanged following the incorporation of the additional wording changes required by the Inspector in her letter dated 28<sup>th</sup> May 2020 into the Council's proposed main modifications to the Local Plan. By way of update, the Council is able to confirm that the Runnymede 2030 Local Plan, with all modifications incorporated, was formally adopted by the Council on 16<sup>th</sup> July 2020.
