This network holds information indefinitely, unless deleted by the end user. There is no indication that files within this scope have been deleted.

We directed you to DIO Theobald James Mr CIO-FOI@mod.uk as DIO is our Data Controller for further assistance.

I explained the other methods of searches we could offer, as well as our SharePoint network I offered to search our E-mail Network for 2018 for any correspondence between ourselves and Esso.

We searched all regions within the UK while using the following terms:

- Turfhill Park
- Esso
- Affinity Water

This search returned one map provided by “Linesearch before u dig”. Unfortunately this is not the map you had hoped for.

I can confirm that within these search scopes, we found no other information to support Esso’s statement.
