HYNET CARBON DIOXIDE PIPELINE: WITHDRAWAL TO PARTICPATE IN THE COMPULSORY ACQUISITION HEARING 07 JUNE 2023

This letter is submitted by Turley on behalf of Peel NRE to the application by Liverpool Bay CCS Limited ('Applicant') for a development consent order ('Order') seeking powers for the delivery of the HyNet Carbon Dioxide Pipeline and related infrastructure (Planning Inspectorate Reference EN070007) ('Pipeline').

Peel NRE is an Interested Party of the application and is the owner of land required by the Pipeline for the Ince Above Ground Installation (AGI), and the associated proposed access, pipeline corridor, and construction compound (as shown on Works Plan ref. EN070007-D.2.4-WP-Sheet 1) ('Affected Land').

Peel NRE previously requested to participate in the Compulsory Acquisition Hearing (CAH) to be held on 7th June 2023. The submission of Peel NRE's Response Statement on 23rd May 2023 provides a cohesive representation of Peel NRE's key issues, and no further information can be provided at this time. As such, Peel NRE will not be participating in the CAH Hearing on 7th June 2023 (or the ISH1 and ISH2 Hearings on 6th and 8th June 2023).
