SUMMARY OF WRITTEN REPRESENTATION submitted on behalf of Network Rail Infrastructure Limited

Summary of Written Representation

- 1. Network Rail (NR) does not object in principle to the Proposed Development. However, it objects to the potential impact of the Proposed Development on operational railway as a result of the proposed cable route. It also requires additional information regarding the volume and type of vehicles proposing to utilise local level crossings as part of the construction traffic route for the Proposed Development.
- To mitigate these risks, NR considers it to be important to secure appropriate protective
 provisions for NR's statutory undertaking and may require amendments to the CTMP to regulate
 the use of the level crossings and as well as to enter into an agreement that regulates the use
 of the level crossings.
- 3. NR requests that the protective provisions appended to the Written Representation be included in the DCO at Part 6 of Schedule 9. Amendments may be required to the CTMP which will be provided to the Examination once further information is received from the Applicant.
- 4. NR will continue to engage with the Applicant's solicitors to move towards resolution and until such time as NR is given the protection and assurances requested as detailed in this Written Representation, NR's objection to the Proposed DCO will not be withdrawn.
