## 1 Introduction

### 1.1 Overview

- 1.1.1 This Statement of Common Ground (SoCG) has been prepared by Chrysaor Production (UK) Ltd (the 'Applicant') in conjunction with <a href="Phillips 66">Phillips 66</a> UK Limited ('P66'), together the <a href="Parties.#">Parties.#</a> in respect of the Viking CCS Pipeline project (the 'Proposed Development').
- 1.1.2 The SoCG sets out the matters of agreement between the Applicant and Phillips 66 UKP66 Limited and also explains those matters which, at the time of writing, remain unresolved between the partiesParties. The agreements to date have been reached through consultation and continuing discussions between the partiesParties through online meetings.

1.2 The Role of Phillips 66 Limited P66

1.2.1 Phillips 66The P66 Humber Refinery is located on the east coast, in North Lincolnshire, UK. It processes crude oil supplied primarily from the North Sea and includes light, low- and medium sulphur and acidic crude oil. It is one of the most sophisticated refineries in Europe. The Immingham Facilities forming part of the Proposed Development are to be sited adjacent to the Phillips 66Humber Re refinery, on land owned by Phillips 66P66.

### 1.3 Purpose of this Statement of Common Ground

- 1.3.1 The purpose of this document is to summarise the agreements reached between the partiesParties on matters relevant to the examination of the application and to assist the Examining Authority ('ExA'). It also sets out the matters that remain unresolved at the time of writing, but which both partiesParties are working positively toward resolving. As such, it is expected that further iterations of the SoCG will be submitted to the ExA throughout the Examination and prior to the making of any Development Consent Order ('DCO') for the Proposed Development.
- 1.3.2 The SoCG has been prepared with regard to the guidance in 'Planning Act 2008: examination of applications for development consent' (Department for Communities and Local Government, March 2015).
