## **Application by Chrysaor Production (UK) Limited for the Viking Carbon Capture and Storage (CCS) Pipeline**

**Case reference: EN070008**

### **Examining Authority's note of Unaccompanied Site Inspection (USI) to which the Application or Specified Matters relates**

Examining Inspector [Jonathan Gorst] (a Member of the Panel appointed as the Examining Authority for the application for The Viking CCS Project) undertook the inspection on 16 July 2024 from 3.30pm.

Mr Gorst undertook a recreational walk from Stallingborough Grange Hotel. The walk followed a circular route on the maintained public footpath/ highway network via Riby Road, Keelby Road and towards Roxton, before crossing the railway line and returning towards Stallingborough passing by the Church of St Peter and St Paul. From there Riby Road was followed back to the hotel.

Mr Gorst had been using OS Map Number 284 to navigate on his recreational walk and had observed several features of interest including some annotated heritage assets. Out of curiosity, he reviewed the Application documents to see how they had been considered and treated by the Applicant.
