## VIKING CCS PIPELINE DEVELOPMENT CONSENT ORDER CALOR GAS LIMITED (INTERESTED PARTY REFERENCE NUMBER: 20047171) WITHDRAWAL OF OBJECTION

We write on behalf of our client, Calor Gas Limited ("Calor"), in relation to its objection to the Viking CCS Pipeline Development Consent Order (the "Order") Application submitted by Chrysaor Production (U.K.) Limited (the "Applicant").

Calor are the owners and operators of the Calor Cylinder Distribution site, located off Manby Road (A1173) and have an interest in Plot 1/73.

Following the submission of its objection to the Order via Relevant Representations in January 2024 [RR-021], Calor have engaged in ongoing discussions with the Applicant. Both parties have now entered into an agreement, dated 6<sup>th</sup> September 2024, which ensures appropriate protection and safeguarding measures for Calor's assets and interests during the construction phase of the project.

Further to the completion of the Agreement, Calor formally withdraws its objection to the Order.
