**Planning Act 2008, H2 Teesside, Proposed H2 Teesside Order  
Response to Examining Authority's Rule 6 Letter**

On 18 June 2024, the Marine Management Organisation (the "MMO") received notice under section 55 of the Planning Act 2008 (the "PA 2008") that the Planning Inspectorate ("PINS") had accepted an application made by H2 Teesside Limited (the "Applicant") for determination of a Development Consent Order for the construction, maintenance and operation of the proposed H2 Teesside hydrogen production plant and associated infrastructure (the "DCO Application") (MMO ref: DCO/2024/00007; PINS ref: EN070009).

The Proposed Development comprises of the construction, operation and decommissioning of an up to 1.2-Gigawatt Thermal (GWth) Lower Heating Value (LHV) Carbon Capture (CC) enabled Hydrogen Production Facility located in Teesside. The development includes pipeline infrastructure and utility connections. Carbon dioxide (CO<sub>2</sub>) captured by the facility will be transported by pipeline to the separately consented Northern Endurance Partnership infrastructure on the adjacent Net Zero Teesside site.
