To whom it may concern,

I write on behalf of BP Alternative Energy Investment Limited (“BPAEIL”), who is a party to a validated planning application [reference PP-12625116] in relation to the HyGreen Teesside project (“HyGreen”).

HyGreen is a proposed green hydrogen project to be developed at Teesside, including an electrolytic hydrogen production facility of up to 105 MWth installed electrical capacity, an associated hydrogen distribution network and other associated utilities infrastructure. The outcome of the current HyGreen planning application to Redcar and Cleveland Borough Council is expected December 2024, and HyGreen is also participating in DESNZ’s Hydrogen Allocation Round process for award of Low Carbon Hydrogen Agreements to electrolytic projects.

HyGreen has land and easements in common with the H2Teesside project (“the H2T Project”) brought forward to the Planning Inspectorate (Reference: EN070009) by H2Teesside Limited (“the Applicant”).

BPAEIL supports the Applicant’s proposed development in principle and has no objection.

BPAEIL is aware that the planning boundary overlaps between the validated planning application for HyGreen and the Applicant’s Order Limits, including overlap of the proposed HyGreen Main Site and one of the areas the Applicant is exploring for its Phase 2 of the H2Teesside Project Main Site (“Main Site Overlap Area”). BPAEIL and the Applicant are in discussions regarding this overlap and it is BPAEIL’s understanding that the Applicant would look to potentially locate its Phase 2 of the Main Site in the Main Site Overlap Area if the proposed HyGreen development did not go ahead.

BPAEIL and the Applicant are also in discussion regarding management of any potential construction overlaps if both developments proceeded to construction at similar timelines.
