EN070009: Application by H2 Teesside Limited for an Order Granting Development Consent for the H2Teesside Project

We represent the following interested parties in respect of H2 Teesside Limited's (the "**Applicant**") application for an Order granting Development Consent for the H2Teesside project:

- Northern Gas Processing Ltd (20049396);
- Teesside Gas and Liquids Processing (20049393); and
- Teesside Gas Processing Plant Ltd (20049397).

Together, the "**NSMP Entities**".

We are writing in accordance with examination deadline 5, to notify the Planning Inspectorate that we wish to attend Issue Specific Hearing 4 regarding the Development Consent Order on Wednesday 15 January 2025 ("**ISH4**") on behalf of the NSMP Entities. We wish to attend the hearing virtually, via MS Teams.

We note the examining authority's indication that it would be helpful for the NSMP Entities to attend both the Compulsory Acquisition Hearing 2 ("**CAH2**") on 13 January and ISH4. The NSMP Entities have filed a suite of preferred protective provisions which would (along with a small number of DCO Requirements) address their concerns in respect of the Project. We understand that the Applicant will be submitting proposed protective provisions which are aligned with the suite filed by the NSMP Entities, which the NSMP Entities will review once received. As such, the NSMP Entities anticipate they will have limited submissions to make to the examining authority and suggest it would be most efficient to provide those submissions at one hearing only. The NSMP Entities consider their interests are most appropriately addressed at ISH4, and therefore do not propose to attend CAH2.

We wish to address agenda item 3 'Articles and Schedules of the draft DCO', in respect of protective provisions sought by the NSMP Entities. The NSMP Entities will refer primarily to the following documents:

- Relevant representations on the change application (RR-044, RR-045, RR-046);
- Written representations (REP2-106, REP2-108, REP2-089).
