The amendment made to the final column of this row at Deadline 5 should actually read "(min and max)" rather than just "(min)"





to account for how this is both the minimum and the maximum height of the auxiliary boiler stack. This is because the figure represents the different worst-case scenarios for the environmental assessments for air quality (where this is the worst-case minimum height) and landscape and visual impact (where this is the worst-case maximum height). The Applicant will ensure that this amendment is made when the next version of the draft DCO is submitted at Deadline 6A.
