2	<p><u>Any outstanding objections and CA/temporary possession</u></p> <p>All objections previously raised by CFL remain valid as per CFL's Relevant Representation (RR-011) ("RR") and Oral Representation (REP4-035) ("OR"). It is not at this stage clear that these objections are capable of being resolved by protective provisions.</p> <p><u>Protective Provisions</u></p> <p>CFL are not currently satisfied that Protective Provisions are capable of adequately addressing CFL's in principle concerns about the DCO application.</p> <p><u>Status of side agreement</u></p> <p>Negotiations are continuing on a side agreement between CFL and the Applicant. It is not expected that these negotiations will conclude before the end of the Examination.</p>
