
Presentation slides from bp's 2025 capital markets update – see Appendix 1 (Document Ref. 8.64) specifically reference that "our H2 Teesside blue hydrogen project, which is part of the East Coast Cluster, continues to progress through FEED and will be enabled through the NEP project we sanctioned."

The strategy also reflects that bp, as a global company, continues to have significant assets and the ability to procure the financial resources necessary to fund the works authorised by the Order should it be made by the Secretary of State.

In light of this, the Applicant can confirm that there is no change to its current position in relation to funding, and the application documents submitted remain relevant, current and accurate.
