As advised previously the interpretation of legislation is ultimately a matter for the Courts and not the Planning Inspectorate and I suggest that you take your own legal advice on this issue. If you have an application for an NSIP or are concerned about an application for an NSIP and it is appropriate for you to put forward your arguments relating to capacity this will be considered by the Planning Inspectorate in the context of the case. Please note that the Planning Inspectorate is unable to make any findings on whether or not any project is an NSIP until an application has been submitted.
