Thank you for your correspondence received 1 May 2013 regarding the A556 Knutsford to Bowdon Scheme.

This scheme is currently in the acceptance stage of the Planning Act 2008 process. At this stage the Planning Inspectorate has 28 days to accept an application for development consent. During this acceptance stage you cannot register to become an interested party. Your opportunity to do this is during the pre-examination stage when the relevant representation period opens. In submitting a relevant representation you become an interested party and will be kept informed throughout the examination of the scheme.

Details of when and how you can do this will be published on our website if the application is accepted to go to examination. A decision on whether to accept the application will be made on or before 22 May 2013.

The relevant representation period will open the day after the day on which the applicant sends out the notice of an accepted application to those who are statutory consultees. The relevant representation period will remain open for a minimum of 28 days.
