Whilst the Planning Act guidance 2008 on the pre-application process states where any interested party feels that consultation was inadequately carried out, complaints on the adequacy of consultation should be received not later than the point at which an application is submitted to the Secretary of State, following consideration of representations received on the adequacy of consultation the Secretary of State, in exercising his discretion, has taken into account your correspondence as part of the assessment of whether the application is fit to proceed to examination.

A decision whether or not to accept this application will be made on or by 22 May 2013.
