Dear Sirs

I act on behalf of the Trustees of the Henderson UK Retail Warehouse Fund in connection with the above matter. My client submitted a Written Representation objecting to the compulsory acquisition of its interest in plot 3/15/a. I confirm that my client has reached an agreement with Highways England which provides assurances relating to the extent of the land which is to be acquired from my client (either by agreement or compulsion). The terms of the agreement are set out in a signed Heads of Terms document of today's date.

On the basis of the terms of this agreement my client withdraws its objection to the compulsory acquisition of its interest under the DCO process, although it maintains its representation that Highways England should commit to physical alterations to the A2070/Barrey Road junction.
