**Notification of hearing and site inspection in the company of interested
parties, and corrections to examination timetable**

I write to advise you that an issue specific hearing on the draft Development Consent Order will be held on **Monday 7 April 2014** at West Wing, Carew House, Beacon Technology Park, Dunmere Road, Bodmin, PL31 2QN. **The hearing room will be available from 9.30am and the hearing will commence at 10am.**

As set out in the examination timetable annexed to my letter of 24 February 2014, those interested parties who wish to speak at this hearing should notify Richard Price (Case Manager) at the postal or email address above by **12 noon on 19 March 2014**. I should be grateful if you would inform us if you plan to attend the hearing even if you do not wish to speak. It would also assist us if you could notify us of any special needs you may have (eg disabled access, hearing loop etc). Please ensure that you include your interested party reference number in your correspondence.

As 12 noon on 19 March 2014 is also identified within the examination timetable as the deadline for other types of written submissions, it would greatly assist the organisation of the hearing if you could provide the above details separately to any other submission you might make.

I also write to advise you of the commencement time and meeting place for the site inspection in the company of interested parties that will be held on **Tuesday 8 April 2014**. **The inspection will begin at 10am and attendees are requested to arrive by 9.30am** at the meeting place outside West Wing, Carew House, Beacon Technology Park, Dunmere Road, Bodmin, PL31 2QN to allow for a protocol briefing.

In the examination timetable I have invited suggestions from interested parties regarding features and/or sites to be viewed during the site inspection, and these suggestions should be submitted to Richard Price (Case Manager) at the postal or email address at the top of this letter by **12 noon on 19 March 2014**. Again, it would be of great assistance if details of any such suggestions and notifications of attendance could be provided separately to any other submission you might make.

Final details of the chosen itinerary taking into consideration suggestions by interested parties will be published to A30 Temple to Higher Carblake project webpage as soon as practicable in advance of the event. Upon publication of the final itinerary, which will include approximate timings, you may decide that you wish to join the inspection at a specific stage. If this is the case you should make your intentions known to Richard Price (Case Manager) as soon as practicable after the itinerary is published.

The inspection will involve the use of a minibus and may include some walking on uneven ground. I therefore request that all attendees wear appropriate clothing for the weather and sturdy footwear. I would remind you that the site inspection is **not** an opportunity to make any oral representations on the application and simply an opportunity to identify physical features that are relevant to the examination.

Finally, I annex to this letter a corrected version of the examination timetable issued at **Annex B** of my letter dated 24 February 2014. The corrections, at serials 4; 11; and 13, do not comprise any substantive changes to the deadlines as issued in the right hand column on 24 February.
