The legislation states in Schedule 1 that "the relevant parish council" must be consulted.

Relevant is defined at the end of the Schedule as:

"Relevant, in relation to a body, shall mean the body which has responsibility for the location where the proposals may or will be sited or has responsibility for an area which neighbours that location".

Hocking Parish Council was not consulted because it is neither a host, nor neighbouring parish Council, and as such, Norfolk County Council fulfilled their s56 duties as the applicant.
