Comment: I would like to support the Listed Building Consent given that this is connected to the ultimate preservation (through 19/00333/FULL) of two important heritage assets: the Earl de Grey (part) and the Castle Buildings.

HOWEVER, I would look for Hull City Council to give permission in such a way that the work will be done to restore the Castle Buildings and that the Earl de Grey facade/partial rebuilding - regardless of what happens later with the rest of the application. My concern is that the demolition takes place - and then the Earl de Grey is never brought out of storage.

Whilst I appreciate the applicant has shown great consideration in their plans for the preservation of these heritage assets I recall that buildings have been lost and work and the original plan has not been followed.
