Comment Reasons:

Comment: The Hull & East Yorkshire Branch of the Campaign for Real Ale (CAMRA) has no objections to the proposed partial demolition and rebuilding of the Earl de Grey public house in a new location as part of the overall proposal for the area. However the branch would like to add its support to the request from the Hull Civic Society that the reconstructed building be laid out in such a way that its historic use as a pub can be continued. While accepting that future uses cannot be determined at this stage its use as a public house is part of the reason for the listing. After all the listing criteria are that a building is of both architectural AND historic interest. The inability to continue the use of this iconic building as a pub would therefore seriously detract from its reason for being listed in the first place.
