## **Details**

The inspection was undertaken on foot. Visibility was good.

The route taken was as follows:

- 1. Commenced at the St Stephen's shopping centre and headed south along Ferensway towards Castle St.
- 2. Turned east, initially along the northern side of the A63 Castle St, crossing to the southern side at a pedestrian crossing.
- 3. Continued east up to High St.
- 4. Followed High St under the bridge and then returned back to the southern side of Castle St.
- 5. Headed west on Humber St to Humber Dock St, and returned to Castle St.
- 6. West along Castle St, then past the Holiday Inn to the Railway Dock Marina.
- 7. West alongside the Railway Dock Marina and then north to the Trinity Burial Ground.
- 8. To Commercial Rd and then through the Kingston Retail Park to Lister St.
- 9. West along Lister St to St James St and then north to the A63 Hessle Rd.
- 10. Across the A63 and along Porter St to William St.
- 11.East along William St to return to the A63.
- 12. East along the A63 to the Mytongate junction.
- 13. North along Ferensway to return to the starting point.
